Server log files

You can use our websites without submitting personal data.

Erhebung und Verarbeitung bei Nutzung des Bewerbungsformulars

Bei der Nutzung des Bewerbungsformulars erheben wir Ihre personenbezogenen Daten nur in dem von Ihnen zur Verfügung gestellten Umfang. Hierzu gehören Ihre Kontaktdaten (z.B. Name, E-Mail Adresse, Telefonnummer), Angaben zu Ihrer beruflichen Qualifikation und Ausbildung, Angaben zu beruflichen Weiterbildungen sowie leistungsspezifische Nachweise.

Die Datenverarbeitung dient dem Zweck der Kontaktaufnahme und der Entscheidung über die Begründung eines Beschäftigungsverhältnisses mit Ihnen. Die Bereitstellung der Daten ist erforderlich, um das Bewerbungsverfahren durchzuführen. Die Verarbeitung Ihrer personenbezogenen Daten erfolgt auf Grundlage des Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. b DSGVO i.V.m. § 26 Abs. 1 BDSG zur Durchführung vorvertraglicher Maßnahmen (Durchlaufen des Bewerbungsverfahrens als Arbeitsvertragsanbahnung).

Sofern im Rahmen des Bewerbungsverfahrens besondere Kategorien von personenbezogenen Daten im Sinne des Art. 9 Abs. 1 DSGVO bei Bewerbern angefragt werden, wie z.B. Angaben zum Grad der Schwerbehinderung, erfolgt dies auf Grundlage von Art. 9 Abs. 2 lit. b. DSGVO, damit wir die aus dem Arbeitsrecht und dem Recht der sozialen Sicherheit und des Sozialschutzes erwachsenden Rechte ausüben und unseren diesbezüglichen Pflichten nachkommen können.

Wir speichern Ihre personenbezogenen Daten solange dies für die Entscheidung über Ihre Bewerbung erforderlich ist. Ihre Daten werden anschließend spätestens nach sechs Monaten gelöscht, sofern Sie der weitergehenden Verarbeitung und Nutzung nicht zugestimmt haben. Sofern es im Anschluss an das Bewerbungsverfahren zu einem Beschäftigungsverhältnis kommt, werden die bereitgestellten Daten auf Grundlage von Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. b DSGVO i.V. m. § 26 Abs. 1 BDSG für die Zwecke der Durchführung des Beschäftigungsverhältnisses weiter verarbeitet und anschließend in die Personalakte überführt.

Proactive contact of the customer by e-mail

If you make contact with us proactively via email, we shall collect your personal data (name, email address, message text) only to the extent provided by you. The purpose of the data processing is to handle and respond to your contact request.

If the initial contact serves to implement pre-contractual measures (e.g. consultation in the case of purchase interest, order creation) or concerns an agreement already concluded between you and us, this data processing takes place on the basis of Article 6(1)(b) GDPR.

If the initial contact occurs for other reasons, this data processing takes place on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) GDPR for the purposes of our overriding, legitimate interest in handling and responding to your request. ***In this case, on grounds relating to your particular situation, you have the right to object at any time to this processing of personal data concerning you and carried out on the basis of Article 6(1)(f) GDPR.***

We will only use your email address to process your request. Your data will subsequently be deleted in compliance with statutory retention periods, unless you have agreed to further processing and use.

Customer account Orders

Customer account

When you open a customer account, we will collect your personal data in the scope given there. The data processing is for the purpose of improving your shopping experience and simplifying order processing. The processing will be carried out on the basis of art. 6 (1) lit. a GDPR with your consent. You can withdraw your consent at any time by contacting us without affecting the legality of the processing carried out with your consent up to the withdrawal. Your customer account will then be deleted.

Collection, processing, and transfer of personal data in orders

When you submit an order we only collect and use your personal data insofar as this is necessary for the fulfilment and handling of your order as well as processing of your queries. The provision of data is necessary for conclusion of a contract. Failure to provide it will prevent the conclusion of any contract. The processing will occur on the basis of Article 6(1) b) GDPR and is required for the fulfilment of a contract with you.

Your data is transferred here for example to the shipping companies and dropshipping providers, payment service providers, service providers for handling the order and IT service providers that you have selected. We will comply strictly with legal requirements in every case. The scope of data transmission is restricted to a minimum.

Cookies

Our website uses cookies. Cookies are small text files which are saved in a user's internet browser or by the user's internet browser on their computer system. When a user calls up a website, a cookie may be saved on the user's operating system. This cookie contains a

characteristic character string which allows the browser to be clearly identified when the website is called up again.

Cookies will be stored on your computer. You therefore have full control over the use of cookies. By choosing corresponding technical settings in your internet browser, you can be notified before the setting of cookies and you can decide whether to accept this setting in each individual case as well as prevent the storage of cookies and transmission of the data they contain. Cookies which have already been saved may be deleted at any time. We would, however, like to point out that this may prevent you from making full use of all the functions of this website.

Use of the Google Analytics

Our website uses the web analysis service Google Analytics from Google Ireland Limited (Gordon House, Barrow Street, Dublin 4, Ireland; "Google").

The processing of data serves to analyse this website and its visitors and for marketing and advertising purposes. Google will use this information on behalf of the operator of this website to evaluate your use of the website, to compile reports on website activity and to provide other services to the website operator relating to website and internet use. Rights of persons affected and storage duration

Duration of storage

After contractual processing has been completed, the data is initially stored for the duration of the warranty period, then in accordance with the retention periods prescribed by law, especially tax and commercial law, and then deleted after the period has elapsed, unless you have agreed to further processing and use.

Rights of the affected person

If the legal requirements are fulfilled, you have the following rights according to art. 15 to 20 GDPR: Right to information, correction, deletion, restriction of processing, data portability. You also have a right of objection against processing based on art. 6 (1) GDPR, and to processing for the purposes of direct marketing, according to art. 21 (1) GDPR.

Right to complain to the regulatory authority

You have the right to complain to the regulatory authority according to art. 77 GDPR if you believe that your data is not being processed legally.

Right to object
